Administrative Items:

• Meeting minutes for the October 19, 2011 meeting were approved with a motion by Pete Berasi and 2nd by Maribel Pregnall.

<u>Updates from CACs/Municipalities/Ex-Officio Members/ DC Legislature:</u>

- DC Legislator Donna Bolner of the Tick Task Force joined the group to discuss the Tick Task Force. There was extensive discussion of the mission and goals of the Tick Task Force and potential role of the EMC.
- Pete Berasi from the East Fishkill CAC updated the group with road salt efforts: John Hickman visited Arlington High School with a salt truck. The students have gotten the school district to switch from straight salt to magic salt. They have also received a reward of \$10,000 from the Lexus Ecochallenge.

- Bob Cohen from the Beekman CAC updated the group with a NYSCEC Trees for Tribs program planting: more than 175 trees and shrubs were planted along Whaley Stream; signs about the work will go up near the sewage treatment plant.
- Steve MacAvery went on the green infrastructure tour offered by the CCEDC, and saw firsthand pervious pavement, stormwater retention pond, a green roof at Marist College, a rain garden and retention ponds at Vassar College. The tour was enlightening.
- Steve MacAvery informed the group of the Natural Heritage Program imap at www.invasives.org, where you can find which invasive species have been mapped.
