- Enabling legislation draft Steve MacAvery reported that the draft is still in review by the County attorney.
- Web site update Jeff Luoma requested that his name replace Zywia Wojnar's as the CCEDC ex officio representative on the EMC web site.

Special Report: Sean Carroll of CCEDC presented an overview of the GIS services offered by CCEDC. This is a tremendous program offering services that exceed many other county extensions.

Reports of EMC Subcommittees:

- 1. Road Salt (Pete Berasi, Vicky Kelly, Chris Robbins): Vicky Kelly reported that she will be working with Dr. Mary Ann Cunningham of Vassar College and Dr. Stuart Findlay of the Cary Institute on a GIS analysis of salt in groundwater in the town of East Fishkill. The group also discussed the difficulty of addressing private contractors regarding salt reduction practices as their customers may respond negatively to salt reduction. These customers may include shopping malls, hospitals, schools and other businesses.
- 2. Clean Energy (Lalita Malik, Marsha Leed, Connie Kustas): The group discussed requesting an update on the feasibility study to put solar panels on County buildings. Researching cost savings from solar contractors or other counties may help guide the decision about whether to pursue solar for Dutchess County buildings. Contacting our representatives may help move this forward.
- 3. Recycling (Bob Cohen, Lalita Malik, Pete Berasi, Vicky Kelly): No new report.
- 4. Resiliency to Climate Change (Chris Robbins, Vicky Kelly): Chris Robbins reported that after he writes an introduction to the resiliency document, AKRF will assemble a draft of the document for the group to review.
- 5. Enviro Fair (John DeGilio, Vicky Kelly, Marsha Leed): Vicky Kelly reported that she, Pete Berasi, Camille Marcotte of CCEDC and Carolyn Klocker of CCEDC will meet on Friday, May 22, 2015 to discuss a joint proposal to fund this event. The group agreed that the EMC needs a collaborator to do the work of putting together this event. Discussion ensued about fundraising possibilities to secure necessary funds. All are enthusiastic about pursuing this.
- 6. Low Impact Development (Steve MacAvery, Marsha Leed, Peter Berasi): No new report

• Jeff Luoma asked the committee to go through old EMC files and slides that are being held by CCEDC. Vicky Kelly and Pete Berasi will do this task on Friday May 22, 2015.
